Truth to Live By

What kind of giver are we? God is looking for givers who are CHEERFUL, GENEROUS and SACRIFICIAL.

In the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14-30) Jesus described two kinds of givers. To one man God gave 1 talent of wealth to put to use for his kingdom, but this man made excuses and did nothing. Some people give grudgingly, give their leftovers or give nothing at all – just like this man. God ordered this man's wealth taken from him and given to others who had proven to be generous and invested wisely in the Lord's work. God gave 2 talents and 5 talents of wealth to two other men who were generous and invested wisely, doubling the value of their wealth (a 100% return). God also rewarded each of them by giving them greater opportunities and responsibilities in his kingdom. In Matthew 19:28-30 Jesus said that everyone who makes a sacrifice, that is they give up something they need in order to advance the Lord's work, will receive one hundred times as much in return (a 10,000% return).

Principles To Practice

- GIVE CHEERFULLY. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver (2Corinthians 9:7). Jesus said it is more blessed to give than to receive (Acts 20:35).
- GIVE GENEROUSLY. God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all
 things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work
 (2Corinthians 9:8). You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous
 on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to
 God (2Corinthians 9:11).
- GIVE SACRIFICIALLY. Jesus saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasury. He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins. Truly I tell you, Jesus said, this poor widow has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on (Luke 21:1-4). See also (Matthew 19:28-30).
